## From the President...

2006 is a very exciting year for the MLTAV. Our committee is enthusiastic and planning is already well underway for a comprehensive program of professional learning opportunities for language teachers in Victoria, including our major conference at the end of April. We look forward to active involvement by many Single Language Teacher associations in presenting workshops and showcase sessions at this conference. Additionally at the conference, we will be launching four projects under the Department of Education and Training's Strategic Partnerships Program (2006-2008).

The MLTAV has been most fortunate to receive substantial ongoing funding under the Strategic Partnership Program. This will allow us to run long-term action-research professional learning projects in the following areas:

- LOTE in VELs from Prep to Year 10
- Interdisciplinary learning in LOTE for languages' teachers in Prep to Year 6
- Assessment for, as and of learning in LOTE
- Intercultural language learning

We are seeking Project Officers to manage these projects. Please refer to the inserts, if you are interested in applying for any of the positions. Note that the deadline for applications is March 1.

2006 is also the year, in which I hope that the MLTAV can launch a major publicity campaign promoting the learning of languages in schools. Whilst we fully support the introduction of VELs, there has been an unfortunate side-effect, particularly at Primary level, where some principals have seen VELs as an opportunity to downscale language programs. Hopefully the MLTAV can be active in rectifying this situation. In this election year we would also like to see LOTE put back near the top of the State Government's education agenda. Watch out for further news on these matters!

The MLTAV is facing a major organisational change from 2006. We can no longer afford a full-time person in our office. We will, however, be employing a part-time Office Manager. Please see the insert for further details, if you wish to apply for this position.

I would like to publicly thank the members of the MLTAV Executive, the members of which have been working hard over the school holidays in preparation for this year. I strongly value the personal support of Heather, Kylie, Les and Adrienne. The MLTAV greatly admires their dedication to the organisation and generosity as volunteers.
