This special edition of Languages Victoria is to highlight an exciting new project which the MLTAV is proud to sponsor in 2007 – the “Next Gen” programme as part of the Melbourne International Film Festival. This initiative has been developed together with the MLTAV. For the first time, MIFF has included a program specifically targeted at young people – with daily screenings at ACMI 1pm Tuesday to Sunday July 27 to August 12, our students have the opportunity to be part of this major film festival and sample the best of global cinema culture.

The MLTAV sponsorship has, in particular, enabled MIFF to offer a greatly reduced price for school groups, only \$5 per head for MLTAV-member schools (accompanying teachers free – 1 teacher per 10 students). The MLTAV hopes that, if the screenings are full throughout “Next Gen”, this programme will become an ongoing feature of the Melbourne International Film Festival.
